

Purpose

Our objective is to update you on the project scope and schedule and to obtain your input on the identified needs, proposed improvements, and traffic impacts along Columbus Street over Plover River in the Village of Hatley. This project is located approximately 0.2 miles north of the Clark Street intersection.

Purpose and need for roadway improvements

The existing Columbus Street over Plover River bridge in the Village of Hatley is showing signs of structural deficiencies. The existing bridge was built in 1958. Preventative maintenance has occurred through the years. The bridge is now reaching the end of its service life and showing signs of deterioration in the form of pile section loss/decay, cracking and corrosion. These deficiencies are beyond what typical maintenance can address.

Other needs identified at Columbus Street over Plover River include:

- Bridge railing does not meet current crash standards.
- Existing bridge width is substandard.
- Significant deterioration of the substructure.

Proposed improvements

The existing single-span steel deck girder bridge will be removed and replaced with a new twospan concrete flat slab bridge or a single prestressed girder bridge. The new bridge will also include crash-worthy bridge railing. Roadway approaches will be reconstructed to approximately 50 to 100 feet on each side of the bridge to tie into the existing roadway. Rip rap will be placed along the stream under the bridge to address erosion.

Proposed traffic impacts

The project is currently scheduled for 2025. It is anticipated work will be staged around local events and holidays. Access to adjacent businesses and residential driveways will be maintained. Columbus Street at the bridge will be closed for the duration of the project. From construction start, the project will take approximately 3-4 months to complete.

Real estate

The project improvements are anticipated to occur within the existing right-of-way.
