Public Involvement Invitation County H over Rocky Run River Bridge | Marathon County

We're writing to invite you to participate in public involvement for an upcoming project on the County H over Rocky Run River Bridge on the border of the Towns of Cleveland and Emmet in Marathon County. The purpose and need, potential improvements, probable impacts, and anticipated traffic control are included in this invitation.

PURPOSE AND NEED: The purpose of the project is to address the County H Bridge over Rocky Run River. The project is needed because the bridge is deteriorating.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS: The preferred alternative consists of removing the existing two-span concrete flat slab bridge and approaches over Rocky Run River and constructing a new two-span concrete flat slab bridge on the existing alignment. Minor approach work on each end of the bridge is also planned. Right-of-way acquisition is not anticipated. If a build alternative is selected, construction is currently scheduled for 2025.

PROBABLE IMPACTS:

- Wetlands: Wetland impacts are anticipated. They will be avoided and/or minimized to the greatest extent practicable. Unavoidable wetland impacts will be compensated for.
- Floodplain: The bridge is in a mapped floodplain so coordination with County Zoning will be completed.
- Rocky Run River: In-stream timeout dates will be followed.

TRAFFIC CONTROL: County H will be closed to through traffic and detoured during construction in the summer for approximately 3 months. The detour will direct traffic to WIS 153, County M and County P. Access to residents, businesses, and emergency vehicles will be maintained during construction.





EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION STA. 8+58.46 - STA. 9+78.44 STA. 10+35 - STA. 11+41.51






