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#### RESOLUTION #R-\_\_\_\_-24 MARATHON COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2024 AMENDMENT: RECOMMENDING TO THE COUNTY BOARD THE ADOPTION OF THE 2024 AMENDMENT

**WHEREAS**, sec. 66.1001(4), Wis. Stats., establishes the required procedure for a local government to adopt or amend a comprehensive plan, and Sec. 66.1001(2) identifies the required elements to be addressed; and

**WHEREAS**, this Comprehensive Plan Update may from time to time be amended, extended, or added to in greater detail; and

**WHEREAS,** The Marathon County Comprehensive Plan 2024 Amendment was necessary to meet WI Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection (DATCP) requirements to fully adopt and incorporate the updated 2024-2033 Marathon County Farmland Preservation Plan and maintain Marathon County's participation in the Farmland Preservation Program tax credits; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 1, 2024, the Environmental Resources Committee held a Class 1 public hearing on the Marathon County Comprehensive Plan 2024 Amendment, with notice in compliance with the requirements of sec. 66.1001(4)(d) Wis. Stats., including allowing for a 30-day review and comment period prior to the public hearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND RESOLVED,** that the Environmental Resources Committee hereby recommends that the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Marathon adopt an update the Chapter 26 General Code of Ordinances entitled Marathon County Comprehensive Plan repealing and recreating pursuant to the Attachment.
