

What is POWTS?

POWTS stands for Private Onsite Wastewater Treatment System. More commonly known as a septic system.

Marathon County Private Sewage Systems Ordinance

To protect public health and the waters of the State, the Marathon County Conservation, Planning, and Zoning (CPZ) Department administers a Private Sewage Systems Ordinance that helps ensure each POWTS is properly sited, designed, installed inspected, and managed. The program also works to ensure the timely replacement of a failing POWTS.

Marathon County - MCDEVCO POWTS Loan Program

Marathon County in collaboration with MCDEVCO has developed a loan program to provide eligible property owners a low-interest loan. The purpose of the loan is to be used to help offset the cost of replacing a failing POWTS.

Eligibility is based upon several criteria, including, but not limited to:

- Owner income
- Age of the failing POWTS
- Category of POWTS failure

The loan applicant must:

- Be the property owner
- Incur the cost of installing the replacement POWTS (i.e. insurance or other entity not responsible for replacement)

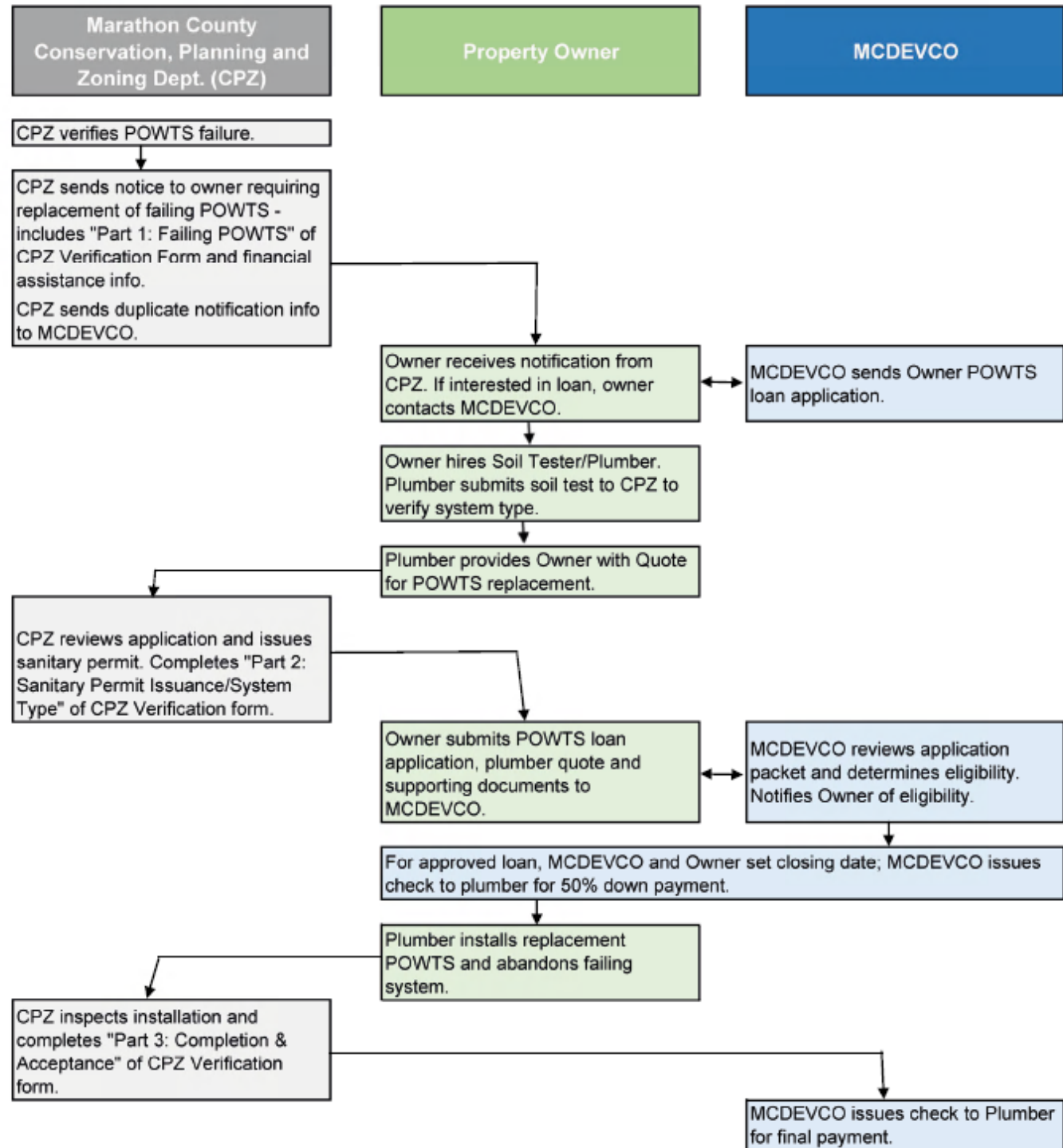
