## **Website Guide to Online Survey Information**

- Benchmark Search: Search by Section, Town and Range. Be sure to have <u>02</u> digits in each search box.
- **Summary Search:** Search by Section, Town and Range. Be sure to have <u>02</u> digits in each search box.
- Survey Search: Search by Section, Town and Range. Be sure to have <u>02</u> digits in each search box. Sections with many surveys associated with them will have an index map as the last document in the list. This index map contains the location of all the maps included in that section and their corresponding map number. For example, map number 24 on the index map will correspond to the document labeled "SURVEY 25 (24)".
- **Tie Sheet Search:** Search by Corner Number, Town and Range. Be sure to have <u>02</u> digits in the Town and Range search boxes and <u>003</u> digits in the Corner Number search box. The map index for the Marathon County numbering system can be found under the "COUNTY SECTION CORNER NUMBERING INDEX" tab on the Surveyor's Office webpage.
- **ROW Data Folder:** This is set up as a folder structure and is not searchable. This information was compiled in 2005 by a private contractor and organized internally to depict Town roads and their widths based on the found information.
  - The "Maps" folder consists of Town maps that highlight all the Town roads and their widths.
  - The "mcscans" folder contains information gathered from Marathon County records and are numbered according to the "ROWspreadsheet".
  - The "Town Documents" folder contains information gathered from Towns and are numbered according to the "ROWspreadsheet".
  - The "ROWspreadsheet" is a spreadsheet of all the documents contained with the "ROW Data Folder". The information contained in this spreadsheet is organized by municipality and references the file numbers of the corresponding documents.
- **General Folder:** This is set up as a folder structure and is not searchable. This information is organized by Town and Range and contains any documents that cannot be included in one specific Section. This information includes Town maps that have been completed more recently by Marathon County staff as well as various historic remonumentation notes and other survey information.
- Railroads: This folder contains a single PDF including any railroad plats and information that Marathon County has obtained.
