 - A. Review of New Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) Data and Marathon County PULSE

Health Officer Laura Scudiere introduced the YRBS data and Marathon County PULSE platform. Scudiere noted that the YRBS data and PULSE platform gives insight of the self-reported health of kids within the Marathon County school systems. These are an example of the MCHD's active participation in data surveillance activities as required of a Level III health department.

Community Health Improvement staff, Aaron Ruff gave an in-depth presentation of how to access YRBS data and navigate Marathon County Pulse. Ruff points out that Marathon County PULSE is available online and is a great tool to view health data related to Marathon County. The YRBS also enables schools to gain insight into the lives of kids within their own community. Ruff gave an overview on the top indicators on the PULSE dashboard, Marathon County measurements, the LIFE Report, and Marathon County YRBS data. Ruff explained the data trends, discussed data breakout details, and pointed out where disparities are visible. Ruff stated that statistical impact is important to note as data fluctuations do occur. Questions regarding data accuracy, and if data indicators exist on specific topics such as vaping issues, marijuana usage in schools, and social media usage were discussed and answered. Committee members reviewed how this data has helped the health department develop new initiatives or allocate scarce resources.
